David, when herding sheep, often spent time, musing, pondering, meditating, as he found solitude a time to refresh and re connect with His Creator.

The day to day problems which seem so difficult to master in the turmoil of the office or workplace resolve themselves when one is alone.

All things pull back into perspective, often a better one. One can stop and analyze one's worries...and dismiss them. The armor which all of us assume in our social contacts falls away. We are at peace with our God and ourselves once again.

Don't be afraid of being alone now and then. If you are...be careful, something is wrong. Make it a point to stop, and take time to make your acquaintance, and reconnect with your Creator.

You'll get a surprise, because you will meet a very nice and interesting person, a child of God that has potential beyond your wildest imaginations.
